We hold up the Lord's light when we hold fast to our covenants and when we support our living prophet.

To the many testimonies at this conference, I add my apostolic witness that Jesus Christ is the Son of God, our Lord and Savior, the Redeemer of all of our Father's children. By His Atonement, Jesus Christ made it possible for us, if we are worthy, to return to the presence of our Father in Heaven and be with our families for eternity.

The Savior is not absent from our mortal journeys. For the past two days we have heard Him speak through His chosen leaders that we might draw closer to Him. Time and again, with His pure love and mercy, He sustains us as we face the drama of life. Nephi describes: “My God hath been my support; he hath led me through mine afflictions. ... He hath filled me with his love.”

That love is evident when we sustain one another in His work.

We sustain our living prophet at general conference, and the First Presidency, the Quorum of the Twelve Apostles, General Authorities, and Officers of the Church. To sustain means to hold up another person, to give them our attention, to be faithful to their trust, to act upon their words. They speak by inspiration of the Lord; they understand the current issues, the moral decline of

Anatevenako ireo fijoroana ho vavolombelona maro tamin'ity fihaonambe ity ny tenivavolombeloko amin'ny maha-Apôstôly ahy fa i Jesoa Kristy no Zanak' Andriamanitra, Tompo sy Mpamonjintsika, ilay Mpanavotra ny zanaky ny Raintsika rehetra. Nataon'i Jesoa Kristy azo tanterahina tamin'ny alalan'ny Sorompanavotany, raha mendrika isika, ny hiverintsika eo anatrehan'ny Raintsika any Andanitra sy hiarahantsika amin'ny fianakaviansika mandrakizay.

Tsy hoe tsy eo akory ny Mpamonjy mandritra ny fiainantsika eto an-tany. Nahare Azy niteny tamin'ny alalan'ireo mpitarika nofinidiny isika nandritra ny roa andro ka nahafahantsika nanakaiky Azy kokoa. Manohana antsika hatrany hatrany Izy, amin'ny fitiavana madio sy ny famindram-po, rehefa matrika ireo zavatra tsy ampoizina sy ireo olana eo amin'ny fiainana isika. Nofariparitan'i Nefia hoe: “Andriamanitra no andriko; Izy no efa nitarika ahy namakivaky ny fahoriako. ... Efa nofenoiny ny fitiavany aho.”

Mibaribary izany fitiavana izany rehefa mifanohana isika eo am-panaovana ny asany.

Mandritra ny fihaonamben'ny Fiangonana maneran-tany dia manohana ny mpaminanintsika velona, ny Fiadidiana Voalohany, ny Manampahefana Ambony, ary ireo Mpiandraikitra Ambony ato amin'ny Fiangonana isika. Ny hoe manohana dia midika hoemanampyolona hafa, mampifantoka amin'izy ireo ny saintsika, mahatoky amin'ny fitokisan'izy ireo, manatanter-

society, and the adversary's increasing efforts to thwart the Father's plan. Inholding upour hands, we are committing our support, not just for that moment but in our daily lives.

Sustaining includes holding up our stake presidents and bishops, quorum and organization leaders, teachers, and even camp directors in our wards and stakes. Closer to home, we hold up our wives and our husbands, children, parents, extended family, and neighbors. When we hold up one another we are saying, "I am here for you, not just to hold up your arms and hands when they 'hang down' but to be a comfort and strength at your side."

The concept to hold up is rooted in scripture. At the Waters of Mormon, the newly baptized Church members committed "to bear one another's burdens, that they may be light; ... [to] comfort those that stand in need of comfort, and to stand as witnesses of God at all times and in all things, and in all places."

To the Nephites, Jesus said: "Hold up your light that it may shine unto the world. Behold I am the light which ye shall hold up." We hold up the Lord's light when we hold fast to our covenants and when we support our living prophet as he speaks the words of God.

President Russell M. Nelson said, when serving in the Quorum of the Twelve Apostles, "Our sustaining of prophets is a personal commitment that we will do our utmost to uphold their prophetic priorities."

To hold up the prophet is a sacred work. We do not sit quietly by but actively defend him, follow his counsel, teach his words, and pray for him.

King Benjamin, in the Book of Mormon, said

Tafiditra ao anatin'ny fanohanana ny fanampianany filohan'ny tsatòkantsika sy ny evekantsika, ireo mpitarika ao amin'ny kôlejy sy ny rafitra, ny mpampianatra, eny fa na dia ireo tale misahana ny lasy ao amin'ny paroasy sy ny tsatòkantsika aza. Mahakasika ny ankohonana, diamanohanany vadintsika, ny zanatsika, ny ray aman-drenintsika, ny havantsika lavitra ary ny mpifanolo-bodirindrina amintsika isika. Rehefamifanohanaisika dia milaza hoe: "Eto aho ho anao, tsy hanainga amboniny sandrinao sy ny tananao fotsiny rehefa -miraviravy-izy ireo fa ho fampaherezana sy tanjaka eo anilanao."

Mifototra amin'ny soratra masina ilay hevitra ho manohana. Ireo olona vao vita batisa teo amin'ny Ranon'i Môrmôna dia nanolo-tena ny "hifampitondra ny enta-mavesatry ny tsirairay mba hanamaivana izany; ... hampionona ireo izay mila fampiononana sy hijoro ho vavolombelon' Andriamanitra amin'ny fotoana rehetra sy amin'ny zava-drehetra, ary amin'ny toerana rehetra."

Hoy i Jesoa tamin'ireo Nefita: "Aingao amboniny fahazavanareo mba hamirapiratra eo amin'izao tontolo izao. Indro, Izaho no fahazavana izay haingainareo ambony." Aingantsika amboniny fahazavan'ny Tompo rehefa mifikitra mafy amin'ny fanekehampihavanantsika sy rehefa manohana ny mpaminanintsika velona isika rehefa milaza ny tenin' Andriamanitra izy.

Hoy ny Filoha Russell M. Nelson, fony izy tao amin'ny Kôlejin'ny Apôstôly Roambinifolo: "Ny fanohanantsika ireo mpaminany dia fanolorantena ataon'ny tena manokana fa hanao izay tsara indrindra vitantsika isika mba hanohanana ireo laharam-pahamehan'izy ireo amin'ny maha-mpaminany azy."

Asa masina ny manohanany mpaminany. Tsy mipetraka fotsiny isika dia mangina fa miaro azy amin-pahavitrihana, manaraka ny toroheviny, mpampianatra ny teniny, ary mivavaka ho azy.

Hoy ny Mpanjaka Benjamina ao amin'ny

to the people, “I am like as yourselves, subject to all manner of infirmities in body and mind; yet I have been chosen ... and was suffered by the hand of the Lord ... and have been kept and preserved by his matchless power, to serve you with all the might, mind and strength which the Lord hath granted unto me.”

Likewise, at age 100, President Nelson has been kept and preserved by the Lord. President Harold B. Lee, at the time a member of the First Presidency, cited the example of Moses standing atop the hill at Rephidim. “The hands of [the President of the Church] may grow weary,” he said. “They may tend to droop at times because of his heavy responsibilities; but as we uphold his hands, and as we lead under his direction, by his side, the gates of hell will not prevail against you and against Israel. Your safety and ours depends upon whether or not we follow the ones whom the Lord has placed to preside over his church. He knows whom he wants to preside over this church, and he will make no mistake.”

President Nelson draws upon years of serving the Lord. His maturity, wide-ranging experience, wisdom, and consistent receipt of revelation is specifically suited for our day. He has said: “The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints is preparing the world for the day when ‘the earth shall be full of the knowledge of the Lord’ (Isaiah 11:9). ... This work is empowered by a divine announcement made 200 years ago. It consisted of only seven words: ‘This is My Beloved Son. Hear Him!’ (see Joseph Smith—History 1:17).”

President Nelson has also said: “There has never been a time in the history of the world when knowledge of our Savior is more personally vital and relevant to every human soul. Imagine how quickly the devastating conflicts throughout the world—and those in our individual lives—would be resolved if we all chose to follow Jesus Christ and heed His teachings.”

Brothers and sisters, we need to do more

Toy izany ihany, ny Filoha Nelson, amin'izao faha-100 taonany izao, dia notehirizina sy notsimbinin'ny Tompo. Ny Filoha Harold B. Lee, izay mpikambana tao amin'ny Fiadidiana Voalohany tamin'izany, dia niresaka ny ohatra momba an'i Mosesy nijoro teo ambonin'ny tendrombohitra Refidima. “Mety hihareraka ny tanan'ny [ny Filohan'ny Fiangonana],” hoy izy. “Mety hitambotsotra izany indraindray noho ireo andraikitra mavesatra sahaniny. Kanefa rehefa manohana ny tanany isika ary mitarika eo ambanin'ny fitarihanany, sy eo anilany, dia tsy haharesy anareo sy an'i Isiraely ny vavahadin'ny helo. Ny fiarovana anao sy fiarovana antsika dia miankina amin'ny hoe manaraka ireo olona izay napetraky ny Tompo hiahny ny fiangonany isika na tsia. Fantany izay tiany hiahny ity fiangonana ity, ary tsy hanao fahadisoana izy.”

Misintona zavatra avy amin'ireo taona maro nanompoana ny Filoha Nelson. Mety tsara amin'izao androntsika izao ny fahamatorany, ny traikefa maro isan-karazany azony, ny fahendreny ary ny fandraisany fanambarana tsy tapaka. Ny Fiangonan'i Jesoa Kristy ho an'ny Olomasin'ny Andro Farany dia manomana izao tontolo izao amin'ilay andro izay hahatonga -ny tany ho henika ny fahalalana an'i Jehovah- (Isaia 11:9). ... Io asa io dia mahazo vahana noho ny fanambarana iray nataon' Andriamanitra 200 taona lasa izay. Nahitana teny enina monja izany: -Ity no Zanako Malalako. Henoy Izy! (jereo ny Joseph Smith—Tantara 1:17).”

Hoy koa ny Filoha Nelson: “Tsy mbola nisy velively fotoana teto amin'ny tantaran'izao tontolo izao ka nahatonga ilay fahalalana ny Mpamonjintsika ho manan-danja manokana sy zava-dehibe ho an'ny olombelona tsirairay mihoatra noho ny amin'izao fotoana izao. Alaivy sary an-tsaina ny ho nampivaha haingana ireo ady mandravavava manerana an'izao tontolo izao, ary ireo ady atrehantsika eo amin'ny fiainantsika manokana, raha toa ka nisafidy ny hanaraka an'i Jesoa Kristy sy ny fampianarany ny olona rehetra.”

lifting and less murmuring, more upholding the word of the Lord, His ways, and His prophet, who has said: “One of our greatest challenges today is distinguishing between the truths of God and the counterfeits of Satan. That is why the Lord warned us to ‘pray always, ... that [we] may conquer Satan, and ... escape the hands of the servants of Satan that do uphold [the adversary’s] work’ [Doctrine and Covenants 10:5; emphasis added].”

Last April, Sister Rasband and I had the honor of joining our beloved prophet and Sister Nelson for the rededication of the Manti Utah Temple.

President Nelson surprised everyone when he entered the room. Only a very few of us knew he was coming. In his presence, I immediately felt the light and prophetic mantle he carries. The look of joy on the faces of the people personally seeing the prophet will stay with me forever.

In the prayer of rededication, President Nelson petitioned the Lord that His holy house would essentially hold up all who entered the temple, “that they may receive sacred blessings and remain worthy and faithful to their covenants ... that this may be a house of peace, a house of comfort, and a house of personal revelation for all who enter these doors worthily.”

We all need to be lifted up by the Lord with peace, with comfort, and most of all with personal revelation to counter the fear, darkness, and contention encompassing the world.

Before the service, we stood outside in the sun with President and Sister Nelson to view the beautiful setting. President Nelson’s ancestral ties to the area run deep. His eight great-grandparents settled in the valleys surrounding the temple, as did some of mine. My great-grandfather Andrew Anderson served on the construction crew of early pioneers who labored 11 years

Nanampoka ny rehetra ny Filoha Nelson rehefa niditra ny efitrano. Vitsy dia vitsy taminay ihany no nahalala fa ho avy Izy. Rehefa teo anatrehany aho dia tsapako avy hatrany ny fahalalana sy ny andraikitra amin’ny maha-mpaminany izay ananany. Hotsaroako mandrakizay ny fifaliana nisoritra teo amin’ny endriky ny olona izay nahita mivantana ny mpaminany.

Tao anatin’ny vavaka famerenana ny fanokanana dia nangataka tamin’ny Tompo ny Filoha Nelson mbahanohanany ny tranony masina manokana an’ireo rehetra izay miditra ny tempoly “mba hahafahan’izy ireo mandray ireo fitahiana masina sy mijanona ho mendrika sy mahatoky amin’ny fanekempihavanany izy ireo ... mba hahatonga izany ho tranon’ny fiadanana, tranon’ny fankaherezana, ary tranon’ny fanambarana ho an’ny tena manokana ho an’ireo rehetra izay miditra amim-pahamendrehana ireo varavarana ireo.”

Isika rehetra dia samy mila ankaherezin’ny Tompo amin’ny fiadanana, sy ny fankaherezana ary indrindra fa amin’ny fanambarana ho an’ny tena manokana mba hiadiana amin’ny tahotra, ny haizina ary ny fifandirana izay hita manerana izao tontolo izao.

Mialoha ilay fotoam-panokanana, dia nijoro teo ambany tara-masoandro niaraka tamin’ny Filoha sy Rahavavy Nelson izahay mba hijery ilay toerana kanto. Manana razambe marobe ao amin’io faritra io ny Filoha Nelson. Nanorim-ponenana teo amin’ireo lohasaha manodidina ny tempoly tahaka ny nataon’ny sasany tamin’ny ahy ireo ray aman-drenin’ireo ray

to complete the Manti Temple, the third in the Rocky Mountains.

As we stood with President Nelson, we had the opportunity to hold up and support the prophet of God in celebration of the rededication of the Lord's holy house. It was a day I will never forget.

"We build temples to honor the Lord," President Nelson said that sacred day. "They are built for worship and not for show. We make sacred covenants of eternal significance inside these sacred walls." We are gathering Israel.

President Nelson and the prophets before him have cradled the holy temples in their arms. Today, around the world, we have 350 sacred houses of the Lord that are operating, announced, or under construction. As prophet, since 2018, President Nelson has announced 168 temples.

"In our time," he has said, "a whole, complete, and perfect union of all dispensations, keys, and powers are to be welded together (see Doctrine and Covenants 128:18). For these sacred purposes, holy temples now dot the earth. I emphasize again that construction of these temples may not change your life, but your service in the temple surely will."

"The Savior and His doctrine are the very heart of the temple," the President says. "Everything taught in the temple, through instruction and through the Spirit, increases our understanding of Jesus Christ. His essential ordinances bind us to Him through sacred priesthood covenants. Then, as we keep our covenants, He endows us with His healing, strengthening power."

"All who worship in the temple," President

Rehefa niara-nijoro tamin'ny Filoha Nelson izahay dia nanana fahafahanahanohanasy hampy ny mpaminanin' Andriamanitra tamin'ny fankalazana ny famerenana ny fanokanana ilay trano masin'ny Tompo. Andro iray tsy hohadi-noiko mihitsy izany.

"Manorina tempoly isika mba hanomezam-boninahitra ny Tompo," hoy ny Filoha Nelson tamin'io andro masina io. "Aorina mba hitsaohana izy ireny fa tsy haseho mba hampitolagaga ny hafa. Manao fanekempihavanana masina manana lanjany mandrakizay isika ao anatin'ireo rindrina masina ireo." Manangona an'i Isiraely isika.

Ny Filoha Nelson sy ireo mpaminany teo alohany dia tena miraharaha sy manome lanja ireo tempoly masina. Ankehitriny, manerana izao tontolo izao, dia manana trano masin'ny Tompo miisa 350 am-perinasa sy nambara ary eo an-dalam-panamboarana isika. Rehefa lasa mpaminany ny Filoha Nelson, nanomboka tamin'ny 2018, dia 168 no isan'ny tempoly nambarany.

"Amin'izao androntsika izao," araka ny volazany, dia "ilaina ny hisian'ny fifamatorana eo amin'ny firaisana feno sy tanteraka eo amin'ireo fotoampitantanana sy ny fanalahidy ary ny hery rehetra (jereo ny Fotopampianarana sy Fanekempihavanana 128:18). Noho ireo tanjona masina ireo dia hita maneran-tany ankehitriny ireo tempoly masina. Antitranteriko indray fa mety tsy hampiova ny fiainanareo ny fananganana ireo tempoly fa ny asa fanompoana ataonareo ao amin'ny tempoly kosa anefa dia hampiova izany."

"Ny Mpamonjy sy ny fotopampianarany no ampahany manan-danja indrindra amin'ny tempoly," hoy ny Filoha. "Ny zavatra rehetra ampianarina any amin'ny tempoly, amin'ny alalan'ny fampianarana sy amin'ny alalan'ny Fanahy, dia mampitombo ny fahatakarantsika momba an'i Jesoa Kristy. Ireo ôrdônansy ilaina omeny dia mampifamatotra antsika Aminy amin'ny alalan'ny fanekempihavanan'ny fisoronana. Avy eo, rehefa mitandrina ireo fanekempihavanantsika isika dia hotafiany amin'ny heriny manasitrana sy mampatanjaka."

"Izay rehetra mitsaoka ao amin'ny tempoly,"

Nelson has said, “will have the power of God and angels having ‘charge over them’ [Doctrine and Covenants 109:22]. How much does it increase your confidence to know that, as an endowed woman or man [or temple-attending youth] armed with the power of God, you do not have to face life alone? What courage does it give you to know that angels really will help you?”

Angels reaching out to hold us up is described in the scriptures when Jesus Christ knelt humbly in the Garden of Gethsemane. By His suffering He provided an infinite Atonement. “There,” President Nelson states, “the greatest single act of love of all recorded history took place. ... There at Gethsemane, the Lord ‘suffered the pain of all men, that all ... might repent and come unto him’ [Doctrine and Covenants 18:11].”

“Remove this cup from me,” Jesus Christ asked, “nevertheless not my will, but thine, be done.

“And there appeared an angel unto him from heaven, strengthening him.”

We have angels round about us today. President Nelson has said, “[In the temple,] you will learn how to part the veil between heaven and earth, how to ask for God’s angels to attend you.”

Angels bring light. God’s light. To His Nephite Apostles, Jesus said, “Behold I am the light which ye shall hold up.” As we sustain our prophet, we testify he is called of our Savior, who is “the light ... of the world.”

Dear President Nelson, on behalf of the members and friends of the Lord’s Church throughout the world, we feel blessed to hold up your teachings, to hold up your example of Christlike living, and to hold up your fervent testimony of our Lord and Savior, the Redeemer of us all.

Nanolotra Sorompanavotana tsy misy fetra tamin’ny alalan’ny fijaliany Izy. “Tao,” ho ny Filoha Nelson, “no nitranga ny fanehoam-pitiavana tokana lehibe indrindra voaraki-tra tao anatin’ny tantara. ... Tao Gethsemane, ny Tompo dia -niaritra fahafatesana tamin’ny nofo; koa niaretany ny fangirifiriany olon-drehetra- [Fotopampianarana sy Fanekempihavanana 18:11].”

“Esory amiko ity kapoaka ity,” ho ny Jesoa Kristy nangataka, “nefa aoka tsy ny sitrapoko anie no hatao, fa ny Anao.

“Ary nisy anjely avy tany an-danitra niseho teo aminy ka nampahery Azy.”

Misy anjely manodidina antsika ankehitriny. Ho ny Filoha Nelson: “Hianatra ny fomba hanokafana ny voaly manasaraka ny lanitra sy ny tany, sy ny fomba fangatahana ny fanampian’ny anjelin’ Andriamanitra, ary ny fomba tsaratsara kokoa mba handraisana fitarihana avy any an-danitra [ianao ao amin’ny tempoly].”
